



MANDAWA

Mandawa's magnificent havelis or mansions, built by rich merchants of the region, display a unique architectural style that evolved around courtyards. The highlight of the havelis is the frescoes that are seen almost everywhere - on the facades, gateways, courtyard walls, parapets and ceilings - depicting local legends, animals, portraits, hunting and wrestling scenes and a glimpse of everyday life.



ROHET

The Bishnois are known as the conservationists to whom the preservation of animal and vegetable life is a religion since the early 15th century. Their spiritual mentor, Guru Jambheshwar was a wise ecologist. He formulated Bis (twenty) + noi (nine) = Bisnoi tenets from which the community derives its name. These include a ban on killing animals and felling green trees, and providing protection to all life forms.



JODHPUR

The Mehrangarh Fort, in Jodhpur, is one of the largest forts in India. Situated 400 feet (122 m) above the city it is enclosed by imposing thick walls. Inside its boundaries there are several palaces known for their intricate carvings and expansive courtyards.
